## LOOK FORWARD IN FAITH



### Finding the light in every child

This project will address the challenge of stigma and the myths related to intellectual and physical disability in Uganda. Starchild aims to build a holistic centre called the Sunflower Sanctuary. This centre will offer support, training and guidance to the most marginalised and help to prevent future generations of disabled people from being hidden in their communities.



### Blether with Beat

There are thousands of people across Scotland living with an eating disorder, and thousands more supporting someone they know. The project will help develop a network of ambassadors. Those who have lived through the illness will share their personal experience in local communities and help others recognise the signs of eating disorders and understand how to support those struggling get the treatment they deserve. This work brings the message of hope that people can and do recover from eating disorders.



### Hear our voice!

UNIDA – which means “together” in Portuguese – is at the forefront of pioneering education that is transforming the lives of young Brazilians. Our project, will empower young women through theological education and aims to provide 3,000 students from low-income backgrounds – especially women and Afro-Brazilians – with educational opportunities at affordable prices. They will also be supported with mentoring so that they can take up leadership roles in local communities.

## Vine Trust

### Kazunzu village of hope

The Vine Trust is an international development charity which enables volunteers to provide medical, home-building and care support to communities living in severe poverty in Tanzania. Our project will help develop a multi-faceted and sustainable village on the southern side of Lake Victoria supporting vulnerable children by providing homes and loving families. It will enrich the life of the village through the development of a community hub, a primary school, health centre and vocational training centre.



## When did it start?

The Guild's Project Partnership scheme was established in 1997.

## What is it?

The scheme encourages members to support projects from a range of six chosen by the Projects and Topics Committee. Guild members can support any or all of the projects through worship, prayer and action.

## How successful has it been?

The success of this scheme has been proven not only by the raising, to date, almost £7 million, but also in encouraging members to expand their knowledge of, and pray for, different issues of concern in the world.

## Why were these projects chosen?

The six current projects were chosen under the strategy of 'Look Forward in Faith' which runs from 2021-2024. The projects offer us an opportunity to look forward and help build a fairer more just world.
