

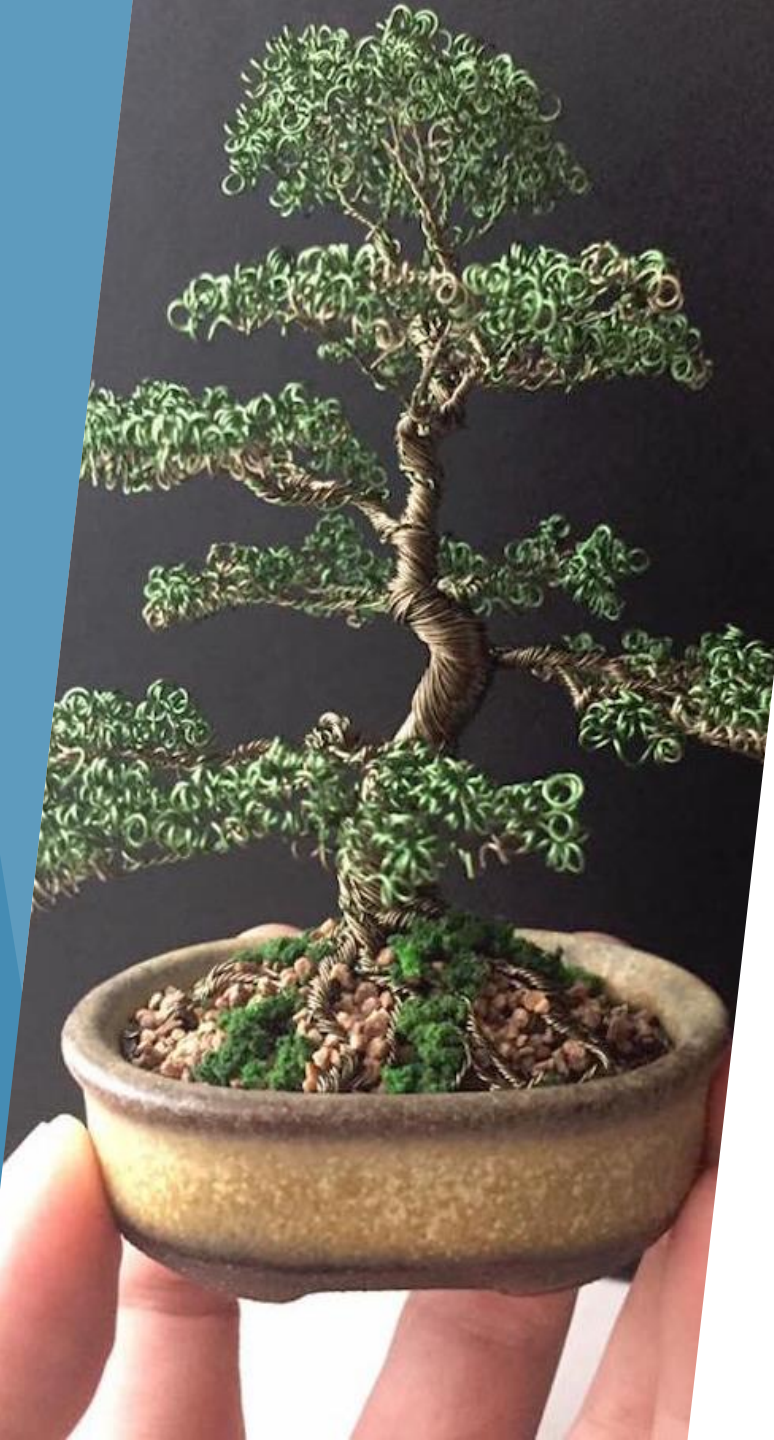

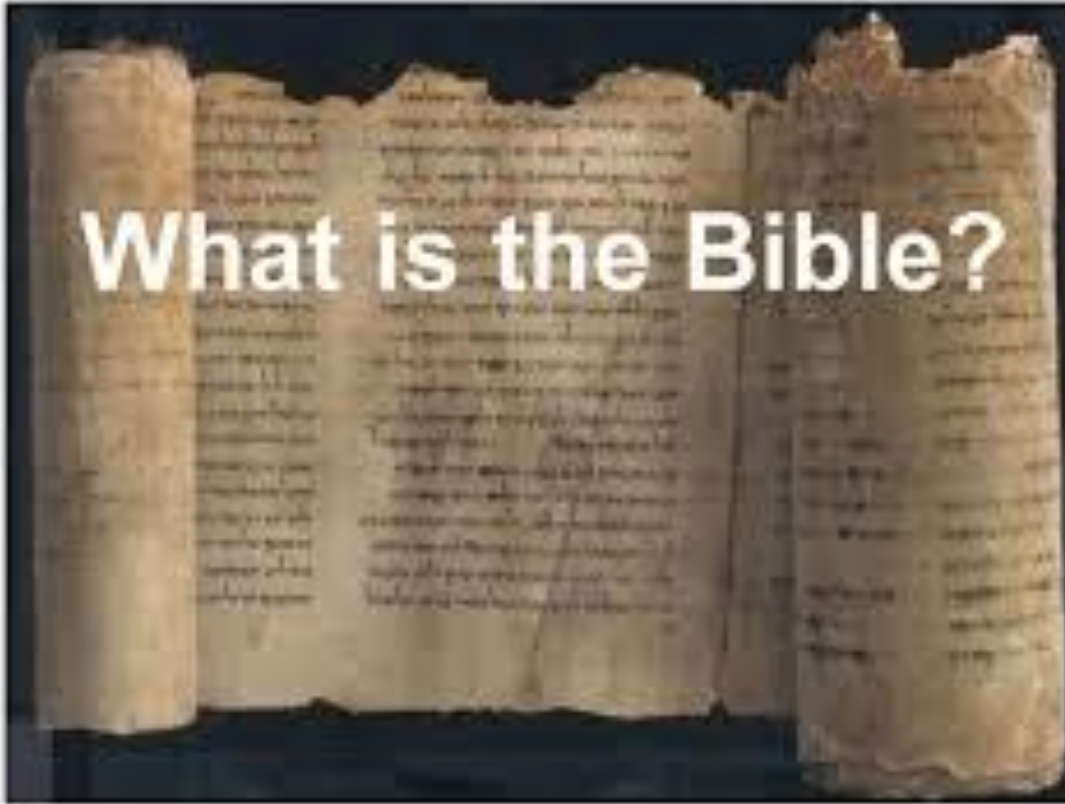

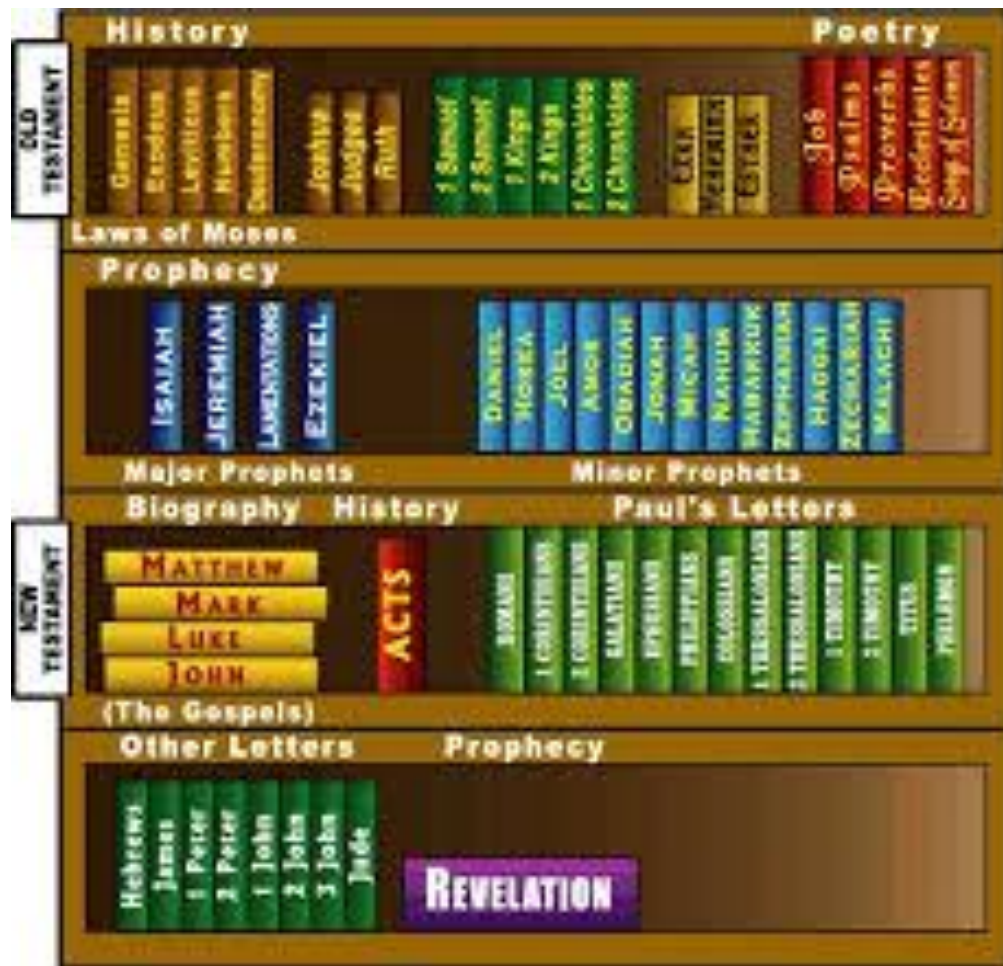

(2 Timothy 3:15–16, NIV)

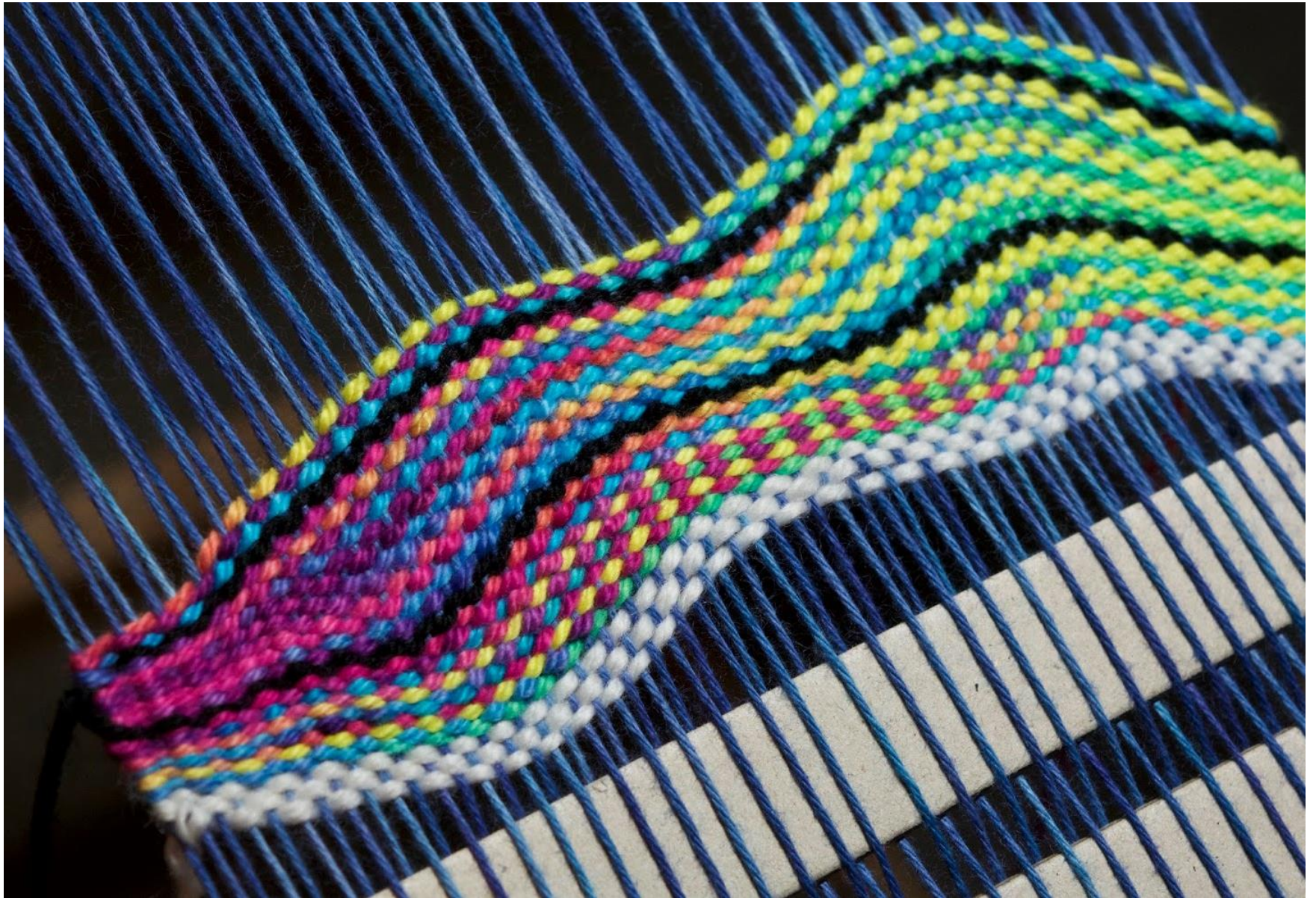


I SHOULD READ THE BIBLE
