

# St Andrew's Psalter Lane Church Junior Church Activity Sheet

## 14<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – Sunday 2 crafts



Here is something to do at home as we can't meet in church at the moment - make a chain of rainbow dollies to pick up on our theme of rainbows this morning.

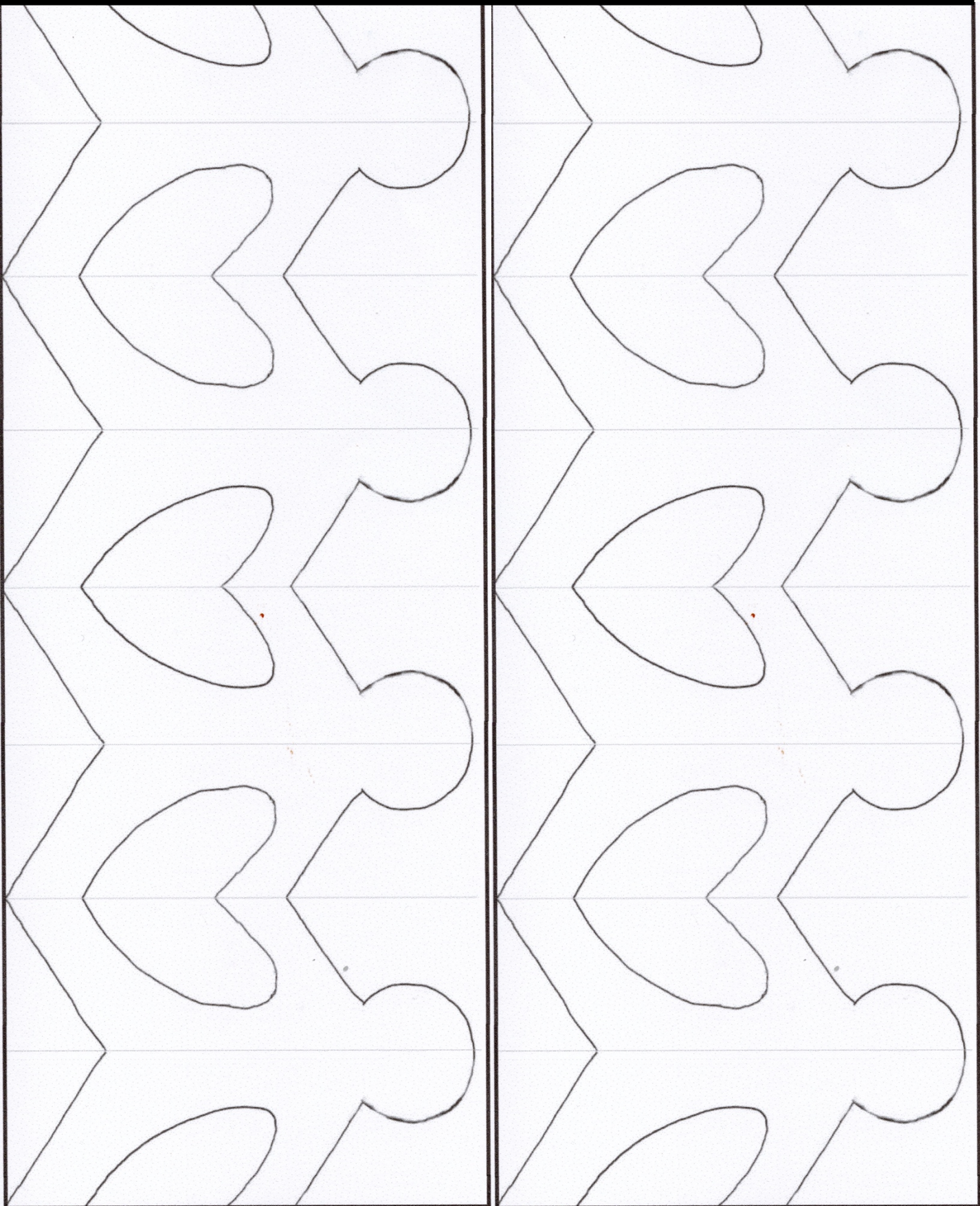
You will need to print the next sheet separately as many times as you like.

Colour the whole sheet in rainbow stripes. Then cut out the two boxes along the dark lines. Pleat each strip folding along the faint lines – you can then cut out the dollies 4 at a time. Don't cut down the joins. When you unfold them you will have a strip of dancing dolls – join the two strips up with sellotape to make a line, or both ends to make a ring. You can give your dancers happy smiles and put them in your window too. You should have 6 heart shapes which you can add to the decoration.



I haven't cut mine out very well, but you will get the general idea!
