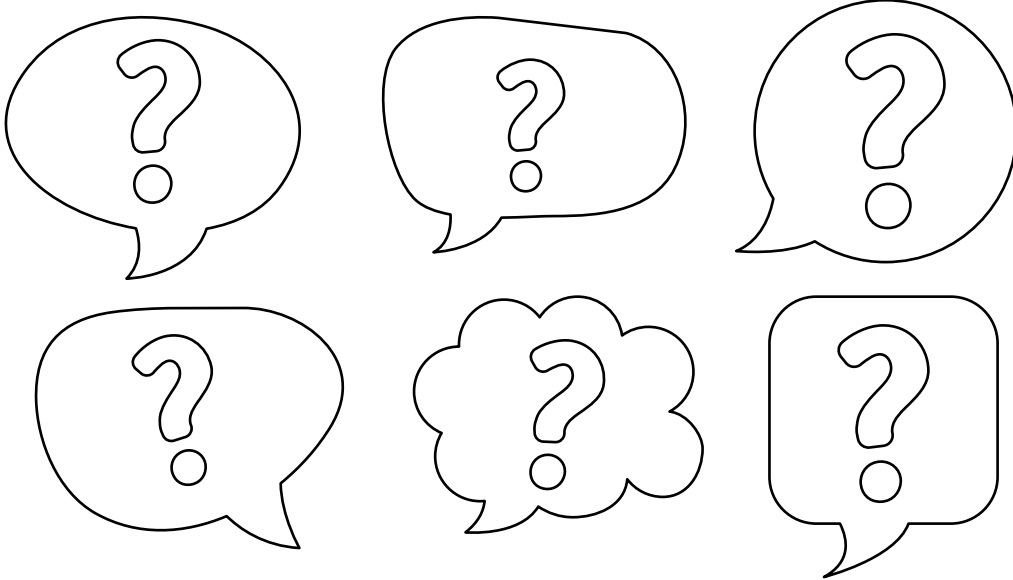




## Deuteronomy 18:15-20

Think about how you can tell if someone is speaking for God.

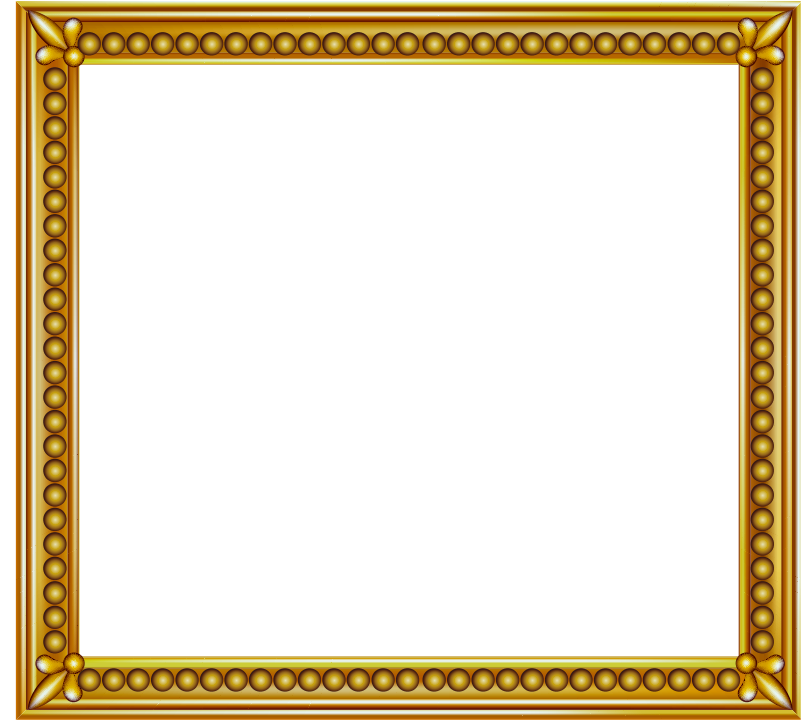
