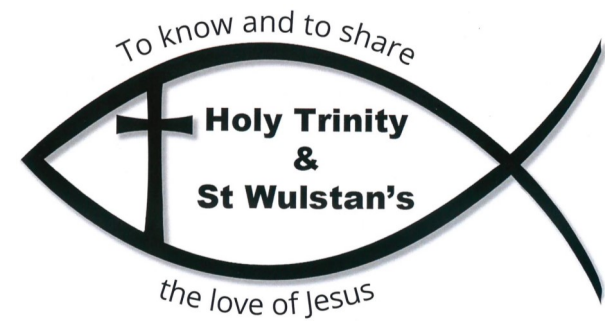

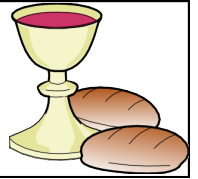
Pie & Pea Supper

St. Wulstan's Conventional District
