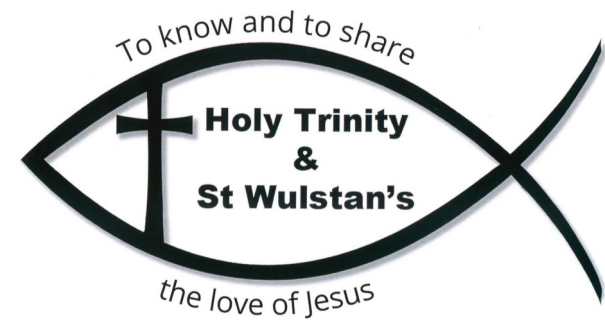

Brownies: Ages 7 to 10, **Wednesdays** 5.45 to 7.15pm at Holy Trinity Church Hall. Sue Waller 430652

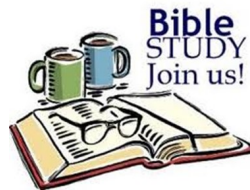

Please speak to Michael or group leaders for more information about any of the groups.



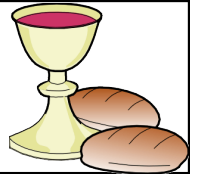
Licensing of Canon Suzanne Sheriff
