

Trinity Praise Report

I'm happy to report that Trinity Praise has been able to continue over the past year thanks to the amazing support of Martin Bloomfield and the wonders of Zoom.

It has continued to run on the second Sunday of the month, although we did opt for a shorter service time of 30 minutes as we felt that this would be long enough for our youngest members to be watching a screen.

We kept all the elements that we could so that the children would still be able to play a game, sing, watch Susie the puppet, have a story, have a time of prayer and enjoy making a craft.

Sue Waller has made up a Trinity Praise bag for each family containing everything that will be needed by the children throughout the service, and these have been delivered a few days before the service by Susanna Dale - Simmonds.

This format has worked very well with our 12 families and we average between 15 and 20 children joining us each month.

We used the same format in December to enable our Trinity Praise families to join us in a simple Christingle service, where they all managed to make their own christingles.

It has been wonderful to still be able to bring the word of God to these children and families throughout a difficult year for us all and we are very proud of each and everyone of them for sticking with us and supporting us each month.

We intend to continue with Trinity Praise Zoom until July and then hope when we restart in September that this will be in person, in church.
