



What to Expect during September & October 2020

Before you get there....

- If you don't feel well or if anyone in your household is unwell, please stay at home.
- Everyone will be required to wear a face covering.
- Based on the current guidance we can accommodate approximately 28 people in the congregation.
- Depending on demand you may need to book. You will be able to do by phoning or emailing the Church Office.
- If you are bringing children along you may wish to bring something to keep them occupied as we can't provide our usual children's groups at the moment.

On arrival please....





- Wear your face covering.
- Sanitise your hands when you enter the Church.
- Sign in for track and trace.*
- You may be given a service sheet.
- Go to the seat or pew you are directed to this might not be where you usually sit, we are keeping you safe by keeping the distance.
- Sorry no hand shaking or hugs.



During the service....

- Please follow the service on the sheet if provided or on the screen.
- Music may be played but we aren't allowed to sing along at the moment.
- We won't be sharing the peace in the usual way (handshakes or hugs) but we can sign the peace.
- We won't be taking a collection during the service, but there will be a box for you to put your offering in, ideally, we would prefer cheques rather than cash, but cash is ok, or a bank transfer. Or how about setting up a regular standing order?
- At Communion four people can go up at once at a safe distance and you will be directed which way to get there and return to your seat.
- You will receive communion in one kind (bread), we aren't taking wine just yet.
- Peter or Jan will have sanitised their hands and will be wearing a mask to protect you.

Keeping everyone safe

After the service.....

- If you were given a service sheet, please take it home with you.
- Please don't linger to talk in the church.
- Please leave the building as directed.
- Please be mindful of keeping the social distance when leaving the church grounds and on the pavement, especially if you are catching up with friends.
- If you become unwell after the service, please let us know so we can let others know.

*Government guidance includes a request for names of attendees to be recorded and kept for 21 days to assist 'track and trace' if required. These will be destroyed after 21 days and not used for any other purposes.
