Boiler renewal

Over the past two weeks, a team of three technicians from 'C Dunphy Church Heating Ltd' from Rochdale, have been busy replacing the Church and hall boilers.

This has included removal of the old, and very heavy, oil and gas boilers that have given good service for the last forty years or so, but had come to the end of their working days. These old units have been replaced with two modern gas condensing boilers along with the associated equipment, that should make the system far more efficient.

The work is due to be completed on Monday 31st, when the system will be tested and set to work, just in time for the Pre School to start their new year.
