NEW TOYS for LONDON CITY MISSION

For next Sunday's morning service, we are invited to bring new toys for LCM to distribute to disadvantaged children. LCM ask that the gifts are brought UNWRAPPED – but they welcome separate gifts of wrapping paper. Really useful gifts include: pencils (ordinary and coloured); rubbers, sharpeners, rulers (with texts if possible); small construction sets, handicrafts or bubbles; Christian books, tapes and videos; large, good quality items such as bikes and scooters (which can sometimes be used in playgroups); items suitable for teenagers. LCM also like gifts for adults, e.g. non-perishable food, toiletries, socks, bed socks, gloves, hot water bottles; Christian puzzle books, etc., including large print puzzle books for the elderly and visually impaired; toiletries for all ages, including perfume, deodorant and aftershave. As an alternative, monetary donations towards the cost of buying gifts may be placed in the offering, in envelopes marked LCM.
