Annual Leave

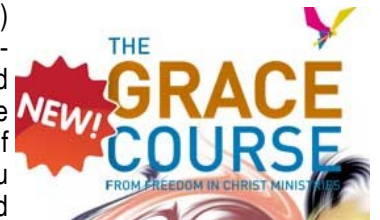
Kerry is taking some leave this week but will be working on Friday.
