Parable of the Two Builders

Can you remember what a parable is?

It is a story that Jesus told with a meaning.

<u>Game</u>

Here are a few of options for games to play:

- 1. If you can, find a plastic box to use for an investigation. Put a big stone/lego brick/wooden block on one side and a pile of sand/sugar/salt/flour on the other. Pour some water in to the box and see what happens to the two different sides. Which one would be the best material to build on?
- 2. Find a cushion and place it on the floor. See if you can build a tower on this cushion using bricks of some kind. Is it easy to do? Now try to build a tower on a hard surface, is this better? Why?
- 3. Cup/brick relay place some paper/plastic cups at one end of the room. One at a time run and collect a cup and bring it back to the other end of the room. Build the cups/bricks into a tower. See how high you can make your tower in one minute. What makes a good tower? Do you want it to be wider at the top or bottom? Why?

Big Questions



This story is about two builders who built their houses in very different ways, with different foundations. Discuss why it is so important to have a good foundation when you build a house. Jesus was trying to explain to people how they should live their lives and what they should use as their firm foundation.

- 1. What is a good foundation for us to build our lives on?
- 2. If Jesus is a good foundation, what can we do to make this foundation really strong? We should read our bible and follow what it says!
- 3. The storm hit both of the houses in the story but only one was left standing. Jesus wanted us to know that we will all face difficult times, being a Christian doesn't protect us from that. However, we can make it through the storms of life by following what the bible says.
- 4. Jesus told this parable because people were listening to him speaking but not following his instructions on how to live. Are there things that God asks us to do that are difficult to follow? Are there any places that it is harder or easier to behave in the way God wants us to? Home, school, church?

I what situations do we need to trust God for help? Ask God for help with something you are struggling with today.




You can choose from one of these craft activities.
