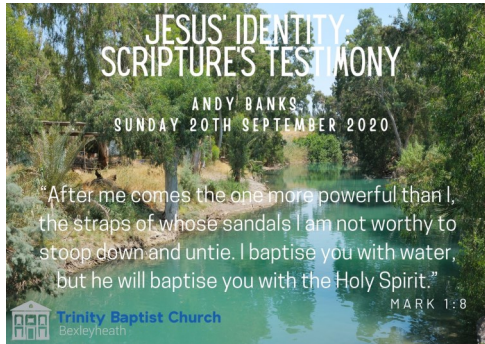

Thank you to everyone who worked hard to get our first hybrid service out last week. We are aware of some technical issues with the live broadcast, which we are working hard to address, so please bear with us. We have deliberately started with a very simple style of service so as not to overwhelm the technical team, but we hope to add in some other features, once we are confident of what we are currently doing. We welcome constructive feedback about the services; contact Andy to do so.

We are continuing to work hard at providing for children's and youth work, hopefully to start in October. Currently, our thinking is towards a dedicated family service once a month, at which GodZone children and their families will have priority of attendance. For YP, we are considering two Sunday meetings upstairs per month, on a rota basis, with material that can be used either by those in church or by those at home - if possible, we'd like to link up those at home and those in church electronically. Thank you for your patience.
