

What do these readings tell us about the place God should have in our lives?

Some people will tell you that putting God first means missing out on all the **exciting things in life**, that it means **never having any fun!**

This is what Satan wants us to believe. He fills our minds, our thoughts with one of the greatest lies ever told; that is by being a Christian and putting God first, we are missing out on life.

Take a **look** at this short video...



God does not want us to live a life that is boring nor does he want us to "miss out". In fact, God wants us to have a full life. Jesus says in John 10:10:

"A thief comes to steal and kill and destroy, but I came to give life—life in all its fullness."

Take a **look** at the quotes below and **discuss** what you think they may mean.





Putting God first doesn't mean never doing anything else, nor does it mean never having any fun.

It means putting the things in your life into the right order. That is, living a life with God as the most important thing – the <u>first thing in your life</u>. After all, God created you and knows you, he knows what "makes you tick" and what your "best life" should be.

Now ask yourself these questions:

And what does it mean to put God first in our lives? Does He take the first position in your life? Does He come first?

Reflect

Recently I was reminded of a song with these lyrics:

"You're not the only song I sing but I love you most of all

You're not the only dream I dream but I hear your spirit call
