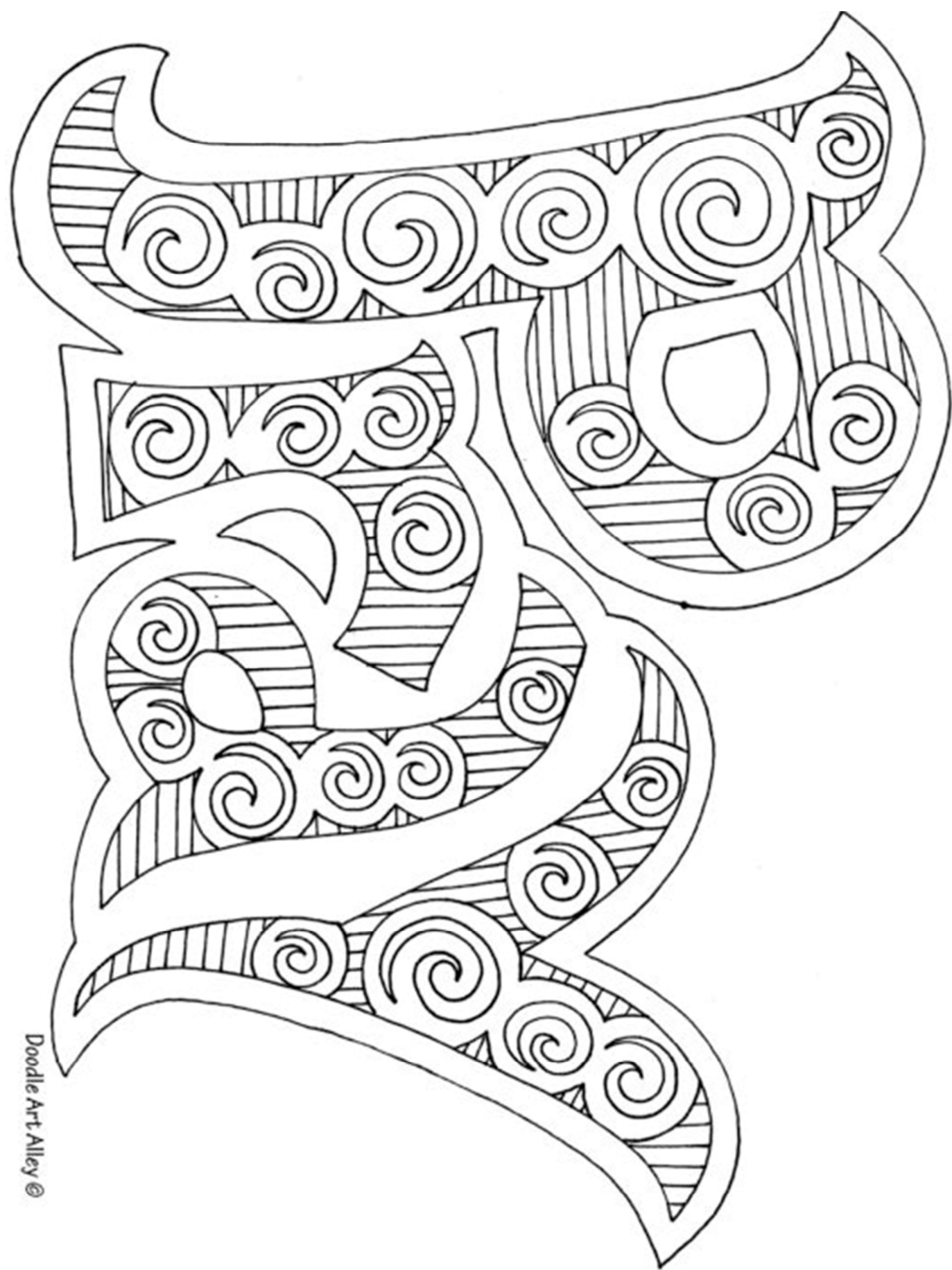

Prayer Hands

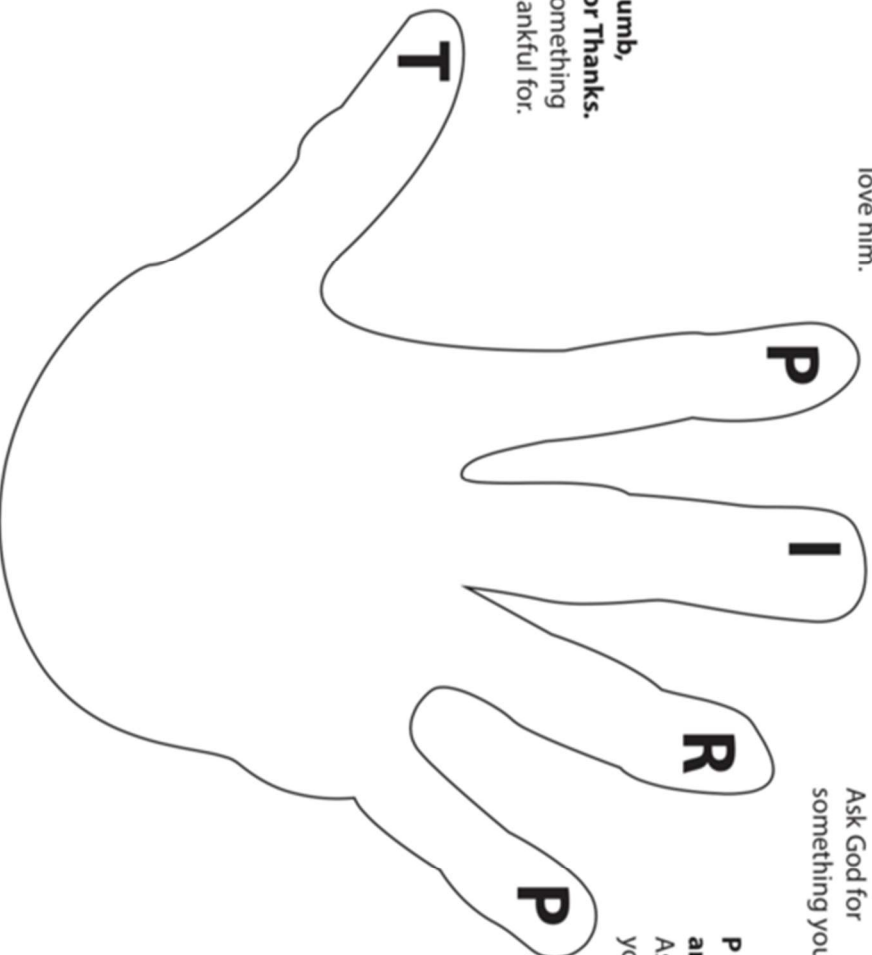
P is for Pointer,

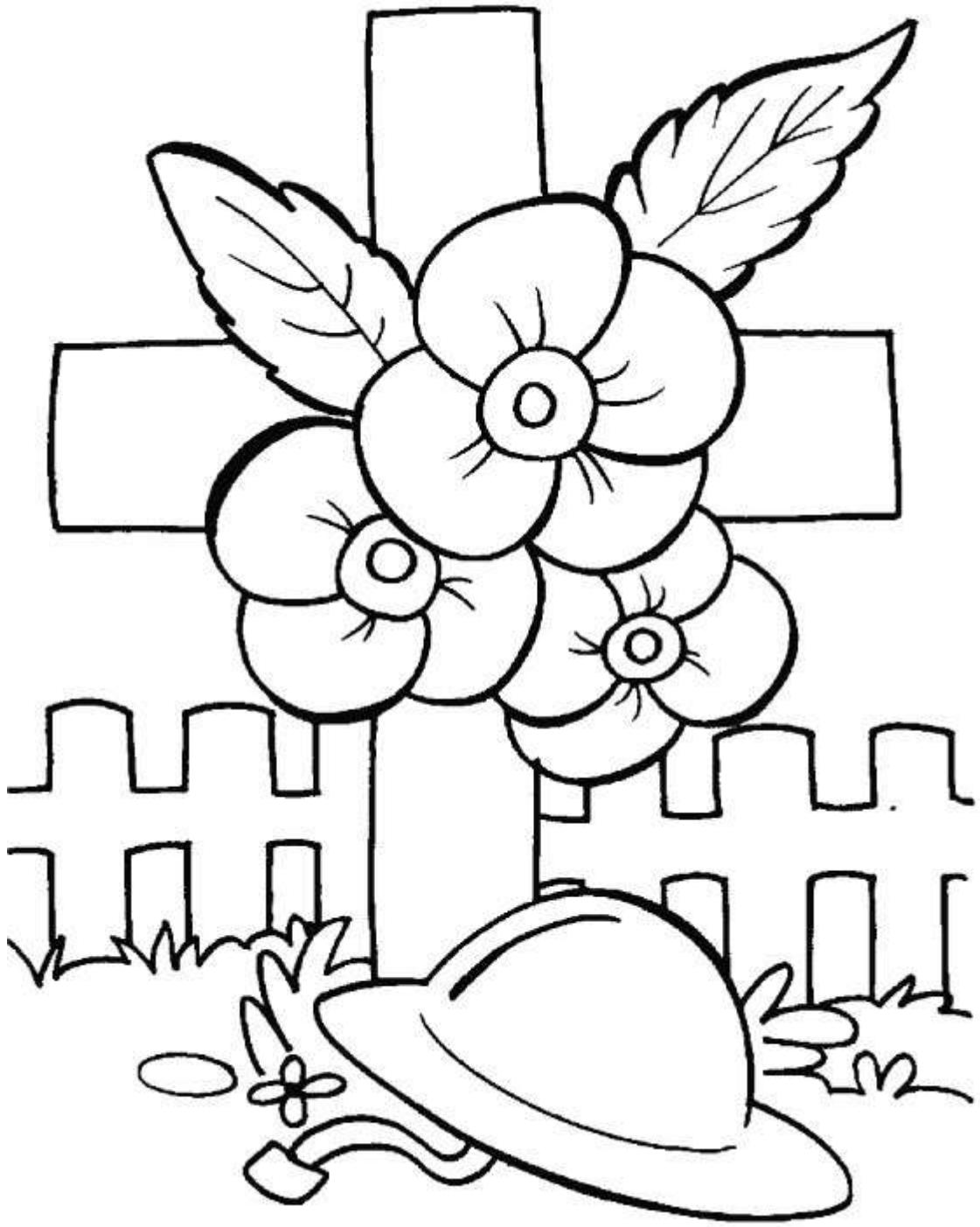
