


WE THOUGHT ABOUT

Prince shared a story from **Mark 10:46-52.**


Read the passage and consider:

REMEMBER

There are times in our lives when it can be difficult to see that God is with us or that God is working.
(Psalm 22)

Sometimes we cannot see God – but he always sees us.
(Isaiah 49:15)

God is always with us and always on our side.
(Deut 31:8)

We need to have faith in God and to trust him.
(Proverbs 3:5-6)

We can call out to him for help – he always hears us because he is always listening. **(1 John 5:15)**



REFLECT AND PRAY

Think back on times when God has stepped into your world. When he has spoken to you and helped you.

Thank God for his faithfulness and love.

Look up or bring to mind scriptures that remind you of God's love and promises.

Write one out to read and think about during the week.

Ask God to show himself to you this week and beyond.

Choose to actively look for him and to call out to him for help.




WORSHIP
