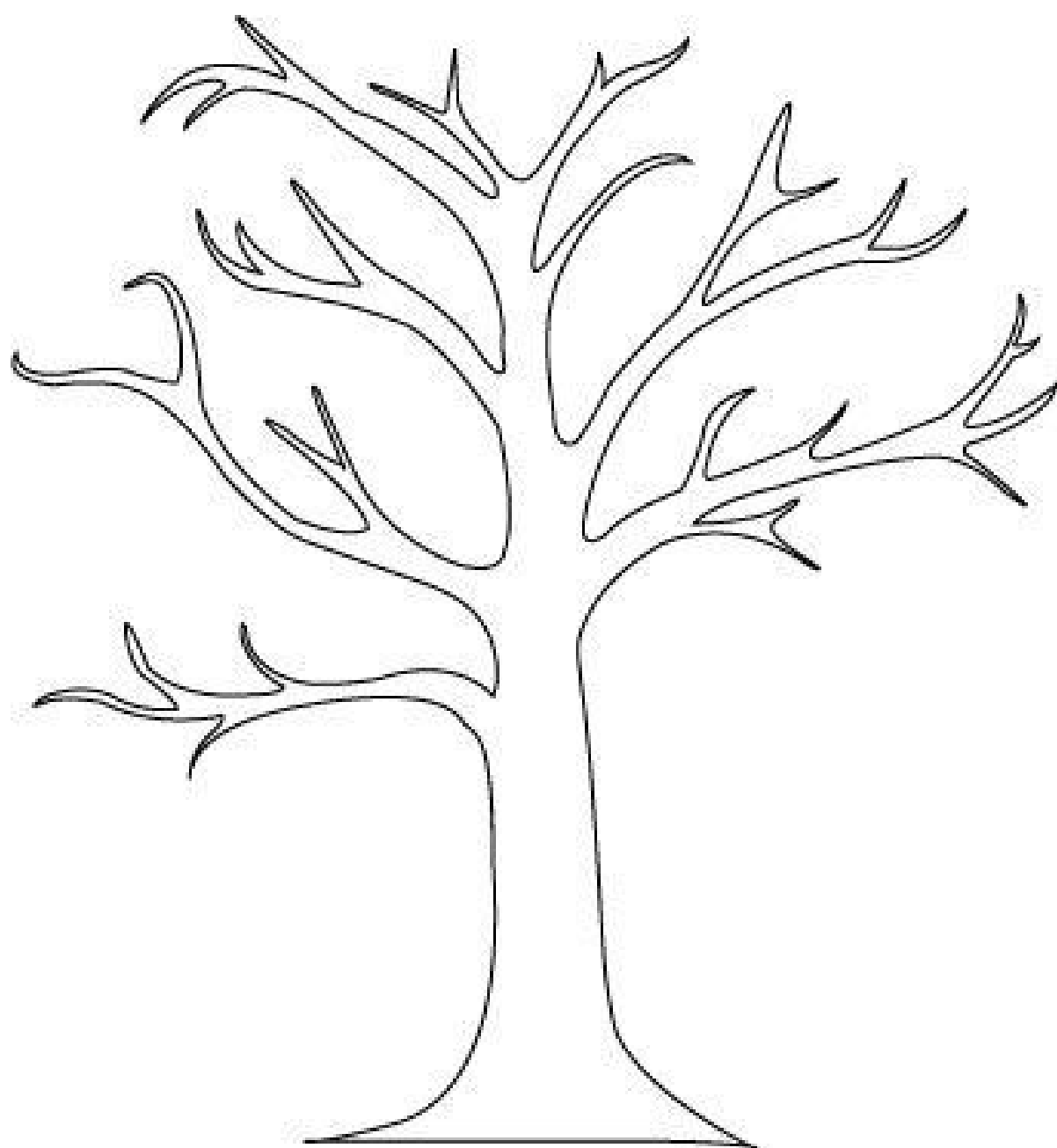

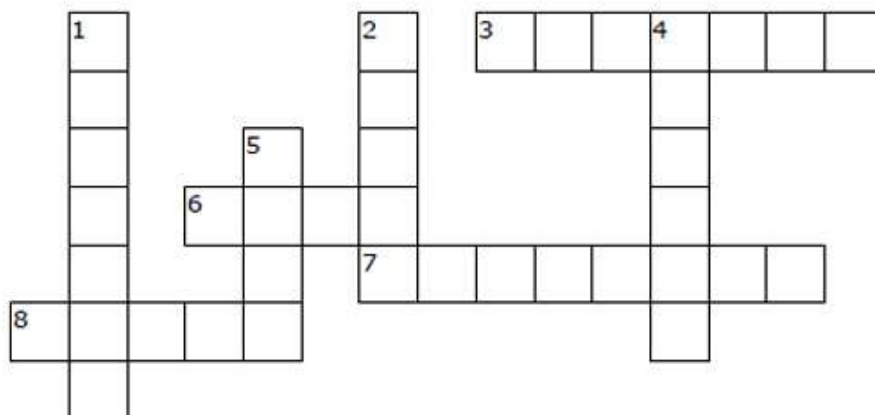


Jesus told parables to teach people about the Kingdom of God.
