Covid-19 Update From The Deacons

You will be aware from media reports that there is no way that we can control what happens with Covid-19 but we can all respond and help with the suggested measures, to play our part in helping make a safer community.

When it comes to care and protection at Trinity, the Diaconate constantly review and respond to information and trusted advice available, and will make the necessary changes to keep Trinity in the best place possible. We will keep you informed of any changes which may be needed to achieve this, and if possible give notice of planned changes. We ask for your help in making Trinity a safe place for all.

We would encourage everyone to consider the current situation with Covid and decide for yourself if you come to church in person or watch online.

This Sunday 19th December should go ahead as planned with the Children's Christmas event, and the Carols by Candlelight.

Be assured that we will let you know, as soon as possible, of any changes which need to be made in response to the Covid situation.

Currently, mask wearing is now mandatory at Trinity, except for those on the stage or those who are exempt. The deacons continue to closely monitor the impact of the Omicron wave, listening to the most informed scientific advice, and will advise the church if there are any further changes necessary to our meetings. Please be aware that changes could be necessary at short notice.

We look forward to celebrating together, our Saviour's coming. From the Deacons.
