Budget 2022/23 and Surplus

As you may know, we are currently in the very blessed position of holding a surplus of reserves, thanks to the generous (above budget) giving of Trinity members and friends, and the provision of a £20,000 legacy in 2020. In the latest cash flow information, this was listed in two separate funds: a £25k "Building Fighting Fund" and £53k of "surplus." This provides us with wonderful possibilities, with the accompanying duty as a fellowship to seek to discern the purpose(s) for which God has given us this blessing.

Therefore, at the Church Member's meeting on Sunday 23rd January, members agreed to hold an additional church members meeting in February in order to give ourselves sufficient time to discern together our priorities in spending this money and in setting the budget for 2022/23 (the decisions we make regarding the surplus have implications for the forthcoming budget and vice versa). The date for this meeting is **Sunday 27th February** 2022 at Noon in the chapel.

Members are invited to prayerfully consider how we might spend the surplus and our budgetary spending priorities for the coming years, and to submit ideas to the deacons by letter or email to Ron Jones by **Sunday 6th February**; no ideas are ruled in or out at this stage; submitting ideas in advance helps the leadership discern common patterns. In these submissions, we are seeking suggestions as to the broad vision that should shape our spending priorities; the financial and other implications of each option will subsequently be clearly set out for members' consideration before the additional February Church members' meeting.

Praying for GodZone

We will be setting up a scheme to get the wider church involved in praying for our children, where an adult is assigned to a child in GodZone and commits to praying for them regularly.

This scheme will be monitored and treated in a similar way to all of the children's work at Trinity, ensuring we do all we can to safeguard our children. Guidelines will be put in place to ensure parents are the contact point and they can choose how much information is shared with the child's allocated adult.

When: 10th – 20th February 2022

Where: Kumi, Uganda

Why: Millions of people around the world need a wheelchair or walking aid and do not have the money to buy them.

Who: The WFTW team of therapists and technicians with pastors and local Christians already working there.

How: Working alongside Elspeth Robinson and the staff of the Kumi Community Foundation based at Kumi Hospital.

Fitting & distributing 131 reconditioned wheelchairs & buggies, issuing walking aids and giving advice where necessary

Sharing the gospel, offering a bible and praying with each recipient

Demonstrating God's love in a practical way to each recipient and their family

Giving local workers a contact point with recipient's families and the possibility of sharing the gospel in the privacy of their own homes.

Impacting the local community as friends and neighbours witness changed lives.
