Appeal Response Fund

Following the request made at February's Additional Church Members' Meeting to support people suffering in Ukraine and Afghanistan, the deacons have decided to allocate this year's budgeted Appeal Response Fund to support organisations working in these areas, half to each area. This has been split as follows:

- ◆ BMS World Mission – 25% to their Ukraine appeal = £1,725
 - ◆ International Justice Mission UK – 25% to their Ukraine appeal = £1,725
 - ◆ Barnabas Fund – 50% to their Afghanistan appeal = £3,450
- Total= £6,900.

If anyone would like to give individually to either of these good causes, we recommend any of the above charities or Tearfund as possible recipients. Giving individually, instead of organising a church collection will enable the charities to also receive Gift Aid, where applicable, which we cannot collect on money that is designated for another charity.

We expect there will be a little extra in the Appeal Response Fund once the actual income for 2021-22 is known, as it is our policy to give away 20% of our actual income each year. Decisions will be made regarding the allocation of any additional sum once the amount is known.
