HE SEES YOU – 17TH/24TH JAN



BELOVEDNESS — 31ST JAN/7TH FEB


We looked at the lyrics of a song called “Belovedness” by Sarah Kroger and why it is important to know and believe that God loves us.

HOW TO: STUDY THE BIBLE (PT1) – 14TH/21ST FEB

The first part of our series looking at how to study the Bible. This teaching introduced 4 steps and how we can use them to explore the meaning of a Bible passage.

Step 1: Observation – Who? What? Where? When?

Step 2: Interpretation - What does the passage tell us about God? And Our relationship with him?

Step 3: Application – What can I learn from the text to apply to my own life?

Step 4: Illustration - Can I explain what I have learnt from the passage to others using my own experience?


HOW TO: STUDY THE BIBLE (PT2) – 28TH FEB / 7TH MAR

We continue with our series on how to study the Bible. We looked at **what** the Bible is, **why** we read the Bible and why it is important to know the **context**.
