Connectedness...how do we connect with each other...how do we connect to God?

It was a shame that we had to close our churches again, especially as some were either getting into a weekly or fortnightly routine of church services or were just about to start. But even though our buildings are closed, we are still very much a worshipping community and there are things going on that are not seen in church; but the Good News of Jesus is being shared in other ways. Have you joined a prayer group? There is one on Tuesday morning and another on Wednesday evening, both online by Zoom, and you can also join by telephone. Circuit staff are meeting regularly, and plans are under way for a Circuit Bible Study in Advent... details overleaf. Various people are connecting with members via pastoral telephone calls, through prayer chains, and of course we are sharing in worship through the online services and the emailed and posted weekly newsletter. Our prayers and our contact with others are very important, even more so just now as we become aware of the difficulties some people who we know, or in our communities, may be facing during lockdown. One of the readings for today is 1 Thessalonians 5: 1-11. Verse 11 says this:


# **Advent Bible Study**
