Grace Food Bank.

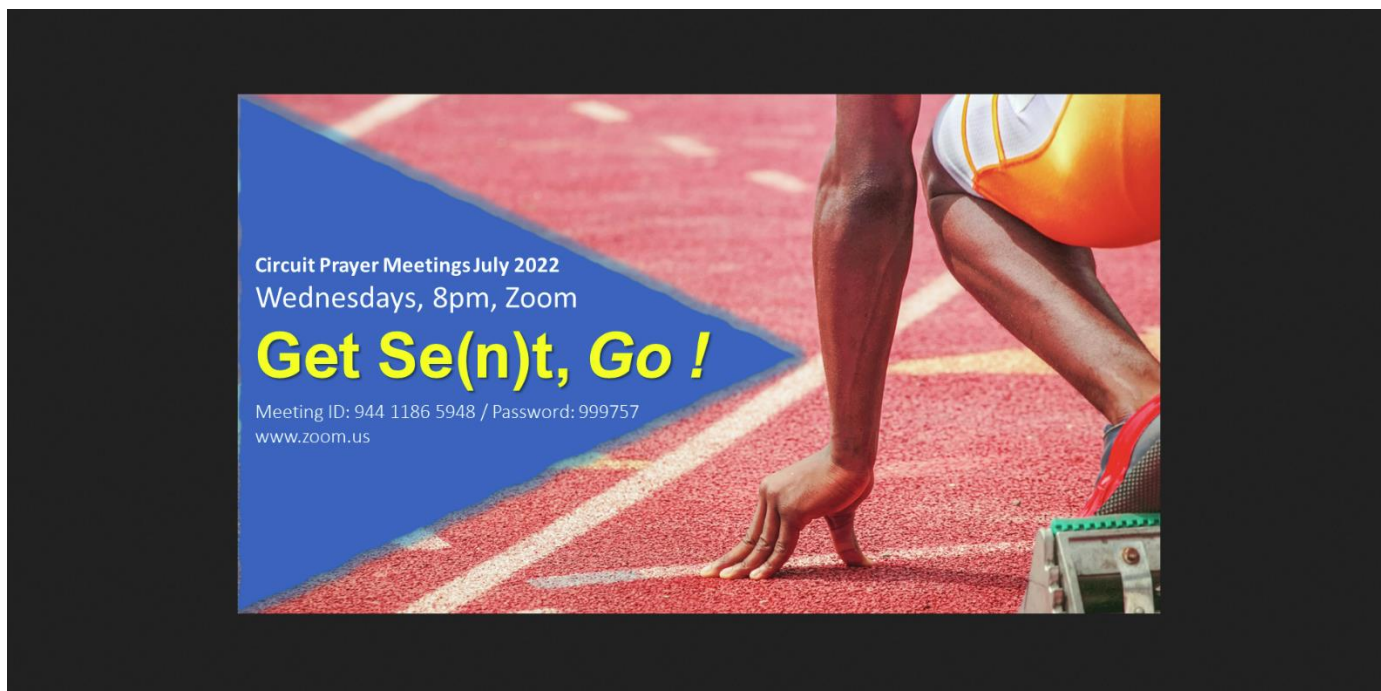
