- A pre-service meeting will be held at 9.45am. This meeting will be for the team on rota that morning and will involve, Welcome, Stewards, Refreshments, Music and Junior Church Teams as well as the Preacher.
- Doors will open at 9.55am when tea and coffee will be served until 10.20am. The cafe will close at 10.20am.
- The car park will be reserved for first time attendees, guests and the disabled. Please respect this policy. If you bring a guest or first time attendee, you may of course park in our car park.
- Double parking is not allowed in the car park at any time. If you double park, you will be asked by the Welcome Team to move your car.
