

### **Statement of Safeguarding Policy**

At the PCC meeting held on 24 April 2017 the PCC of

All Saints New Haw, Runnymede Deanery

adopted the Church Of England "Promoting a Safer Church" Policy Statement, national policies and Practice Guidance of the House of Bishops and supporting diocesan safeguarding protocols.

The Policies and Practice Guidance applies to all Church bodies and officers and under new legislation all authorised clergy, bishops, archdeacons licensed readers and lay workers, church wardens and PCCs must have due regard to safeguarding guidance issued by the House of Bishops.
