To our **Word & Worship Service** today with Rev. Dozie Moneme. This is the second in our Autumn series looking at the New Testament book of Ephesians. This week Chapter 2 Verses 1-22 (Page 1174 in the church bibles). "Saved by grace, raised and exalted by Christ and the inclusion of Gentiles into one body."

## Shoebox Appeal Launch 2021

This Sunday starts our launch for St Paul's 2021 Shoebox Appeal. We shall be showing the Operation Christmas Child campaign video at the end of this Sunday's service.

Over the next 6-7 weeks we will be asking for items that can be donated for the Appeal. Leaflets will be available with lists of suitable items that can be donated. A big reminder is that no liquids or food items may be included but hand knitted, stuffed toys

are once again allowed. Our large collection box will be sited in the porch.

You can support the Appeal by donating items, money, praying for this year's campaign, or giving time to help wrap and/or pack boxes. Any financial support should be clearly marked as Shoebox Appeal. A reminder that there is a £5 cost for each box for transport to its destination and for supporting the local churches in delivering the Greatest Journey 12 week teaching programme for the children who receive boxes.

Last year 9million boxes were distributed in over 100 countries and 1.1million children gave their lives to Christ a fantastic God blessed achievement during the pandemic.

Wrapping and packing dates will follow. So, in the meantime look out for bargains and let us spread God's love with Good News and Great Joy.
