The Church is the Body of Christ, the people of God and the dwelling-place of the Holy Spirit. In baptism the whole Church is summoned to witness to God's love and to work for the coming of his kingdom.

To serve this royal priesthood, God has given particular ministries. Priests are ordained to lead God's people in the offering of praise and the proclamation of the gospel. They share with the Bishop in the oversight of the Church, delighting in its beauty and rejoicing in its well-being. They are to set the example of the Good Shepherd<sup>5</sup> always before them as the pattern of their calling. With the Bishop and their fellow presbyters, they are to sustain the community of the faithful by the ministry of word and sacrament, that we all may grow into the fullness of Christ and be a living sacrifice acceptable to God.

Through your Spirit, heavenly Father,  
 give these your servants grace and power  
 to proclaim the gospel of your salvation  
 and minister the sacraments of the new covenant.  
 Renew them in holiness,  
 and give them wisdom and discipline  
 to work faithfully with those committed to their charge.
