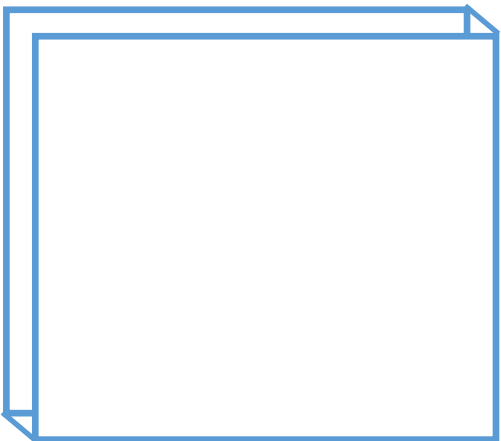
Don't forget to turn off the tap completely when washing your hands.



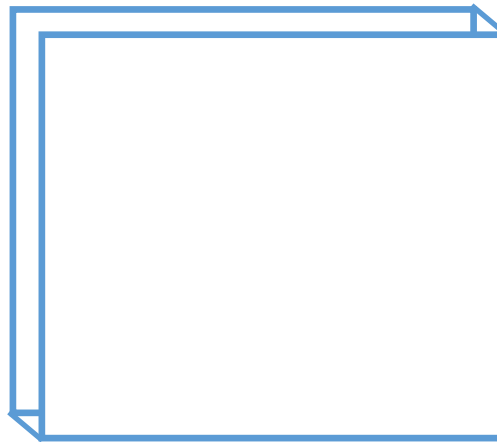
Only use the washing machine or dishwasher when it is full.



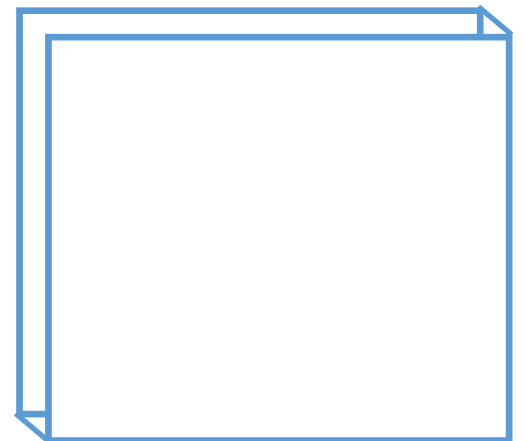
Prevent water pollution by putting rubbish into dustbins not into nature.

gels.

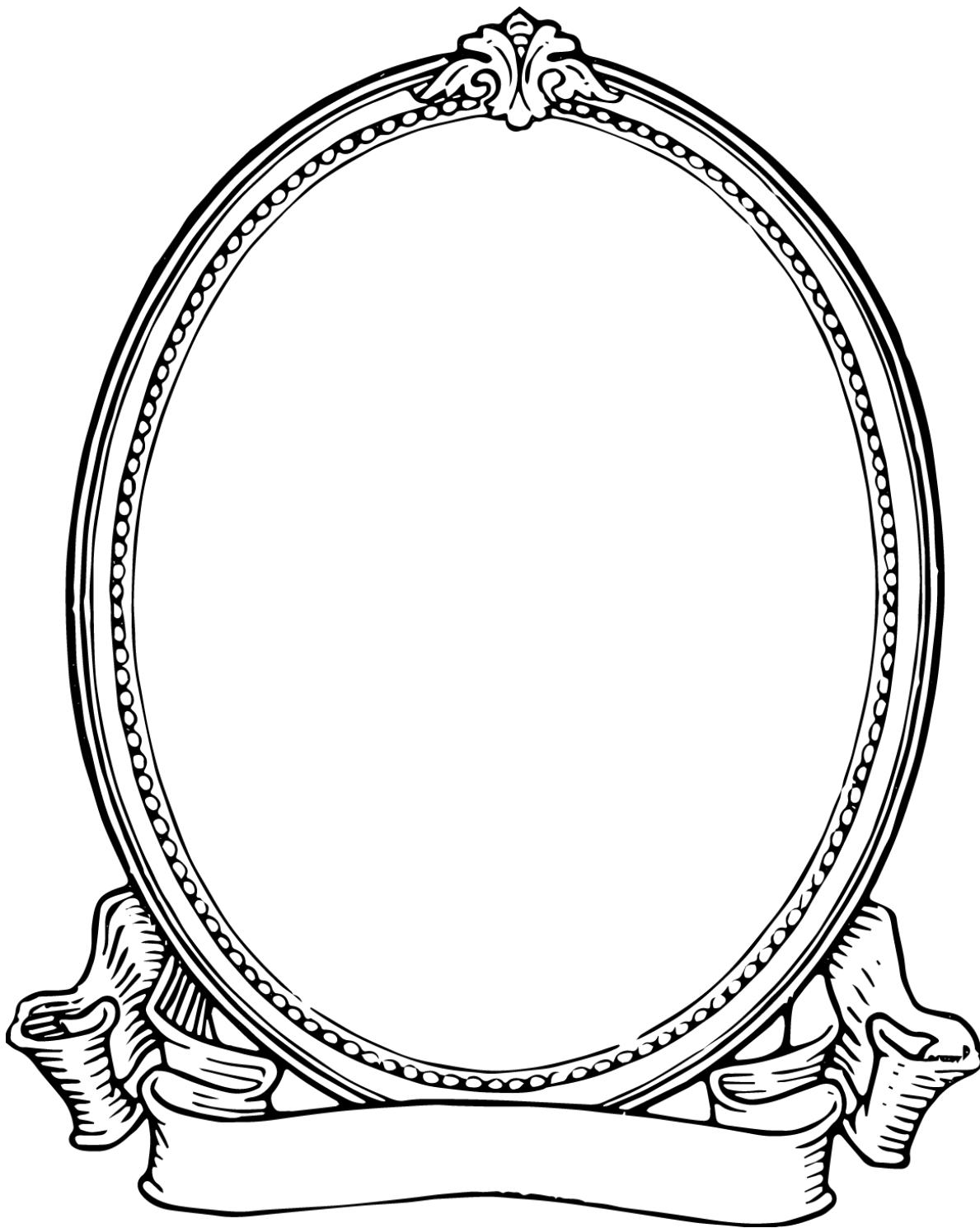
And you crowned him with glory and

¹³ Keep me from the sins that I want to do.

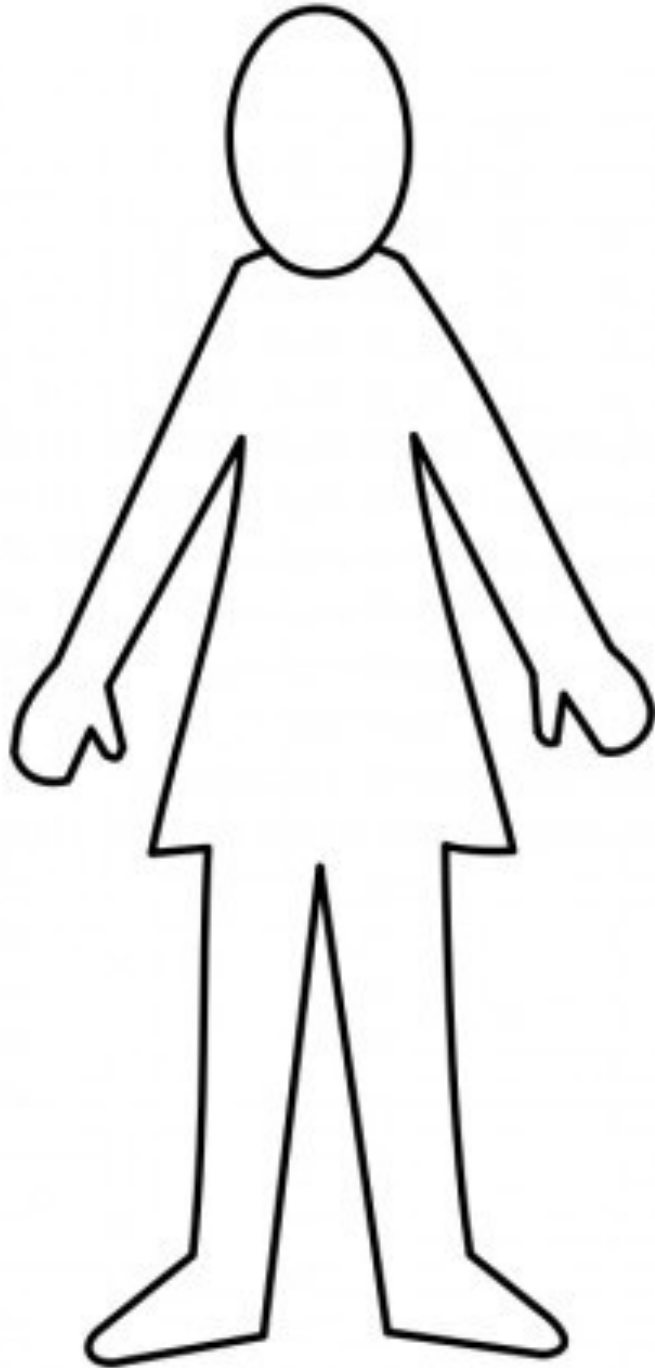
