Leaflet

The purpose of this leaflet is to give you a brief history and to invite you to become a **friend** of our Church.

Building

The site on which this building stands has been used for religious purposes for more than 750 years.

The *Chapel of Forfar* was built here in 1241 and when in 1591 the main seat of religion of the area, Restenneth Priory, located a few miles east of the town fell into disrepair and religious services ceased there *Forfar* assumed the role of Parish Church.

This building replaced the original in 1789/90; the architect John Gibson of St Cyrus designed the building to house 2000 people at a cost of £2000.

In 1898/99 the interior was massively altered to accommodate the organ; the gallery to the north was disposed of, two gallery staircases and a new north wall being built to access the remaining galleries.

Other features of note:

the stained glass windows, two of which were donated in 1887 (Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee) by Sir Thomas Thornton and his brother George;

the grave of George Don the famous botanist born at Menmuir 1764;

and the bell Lang Strang, donated by Robert Strang in 1657.
