#### Advice from the Diocese - Coronavirus

The Church of England and the Diocese have sent out a letter this week with guidance on reducing the risks of spreading Coronavirus and other pathogens.

We have been asked to avoid intincting: "Intinction (dipping), often thought to be a practice at the time of communion which reduces the risk of contagion, may actually increase such risk. Our hands are far more likely to be a source of contagious pathogens than lips.

Consider receiving Holy Communion in one kind: It is Anglican teaching that to receive the sacrament in one kind only is to receive the sacrament in its entirety. Should a communicant not wish to drink from the chalice then he or she ought to receive the consecrated bread alone."

As with all infection control, good hand hygiene is paramount.
