






## Prayers of repentance

and our relationship with you.


We pray for each church within our local community,

We pray for all those in work that they may be kept safe. Keep us alert to the hazards that are in our workplaces and help us to work safely and well.


We particularly pray for those who work at home and for their mental wellbeing. Inspire their colleagues to keep in touch with them so they do not feel abandoned, isolated and alone.




## A prayer for those feeling tired and pressured

Lord in your mercy, hear our prayer.



God, please be with those who have not been blessed with a child.


Please be with those whose children have been too perfect for this Earth and are with you in heaven.





**Amen**


