**Are face masks still required during the Baptism Service?** Yes please! If you are exempt from wearing a face mask, please do let us know.



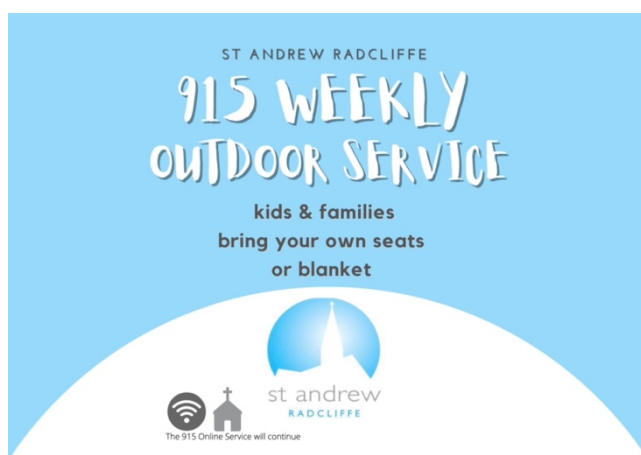
### **YOUR BAPTISM DAY IS PROVISIONALLY BOOKED**
