

Safeguarding Policy Statement

Chester Diocesan Cursillo

**This policy will be reviewed each year
to monitor the progress that has been achieved.**

1. We recognise that everyone has different levels of vulnerability and that each of us may be regarded as vulnerable at some time in our lives.
2. As members of Chester Diocesan Cursillo we commit ourselves to respectful pastoral for all to whom we minister.
3. We commit ourselves to the safeguarding of people who may be vulnerable, ensuring their wellbeing as part of the Cursillo movement.
4. We commit ourselves to promoting safe practice by those in positions of trust.
5. Chester Diocesan Cursillo commits itself to the inclusion and empowerment of adults at risk.
6. It is the responsibility of each of us to prevent the physical, emotional, sexual, financial and spiritual abuse of vulnerable people and **to report** any such abuse that we discover or suspect.
7. We undertake to exercise proper care in the appointment and selection of those who work with adults at risk.
8. Chester Cursillo is committed to supporting, resourcing, training and regularly reviewing those who undertake work amongst vulnerable adults.
9. Cursillo adopts the guidelines of Chester Diocese and the Church of England.
10. Each person who works with vulnerable people will agree to abide by these recommendations and the guidelines established by Chester Cursillo.
