The Days Of Creation

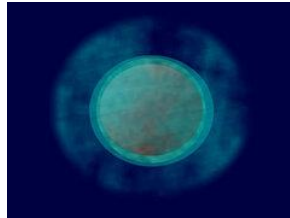
Genesis 1:1-2:3

Then on the first day God gave us the gift of Light so now there is not just darkness, but there is light and dark.



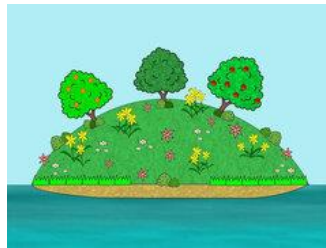
God gave us the gift of the light, that all light comes from. And when God saw the light, God said "it is good." and that was the end of the first day.

On the second day God gave us the gift of water. Not just any water this is the water that all the rest of water comes from.



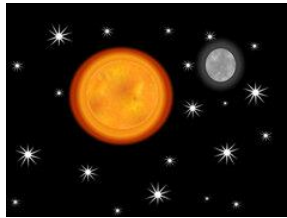
When God saw the water, God said "it is good." and that was the end of the second day.

When God saw the dry land and green and growing things God said "It is good." and that was the end of the third day

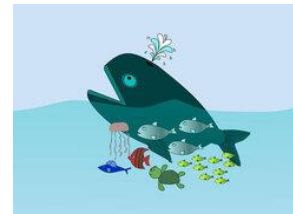
On the fourth day God gave us the gift of the day and the night. God gave us a way to count our days.

Instructions

1 x Glass Jar

PVA Glue

Glue Sticks

Tissue Paper

Pens

Card



You might like to start by decorating your 'thankfulness jar' with the tissue paper and PVA glue. You can use it to make different patterns or you could just cover it in one colour.

Once you have decorated your thankfulness jar, you might want to cut up little squares of coloured paper. Once you've done that, you can write something that you're thankful for on a piece of card, fold it, and put it in the jar to be read at some point in the future.
