
God gives Solomon wisdom

When Solomon became king, He went to the most important High Place at Gibeon to offer a sacrifice to God.






Solomon offered a thousand burnt offerings at the altar. That night, in a dream, God said, 'Ask for whatever you want me to give you.'

govern this great people of yours?'




'I will give you a wise and discerning heart, more than anyone else before you or anyone else to come.'

These types of judgment and the great Proverbs that Solomon wrote made him famous for his wisdom

5 Finger Prayer




 The middle finger is the tallest. Pray for leaders in government, business, and the church.
