Readings

Psalm 25:1-9

- ¹ In you, Lord my God, I put my trust.
- ²I trust in you; do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.
- ³ No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those who are treacherous without cause.
- ⁴Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths.
- ⁵ Guide me in your truth and teach me,

- for you are God my Saviour, and my hope is in you all day long.
- ⁶Remember, Lord, your great mercy and love,
 - for they are from of old.
- ⁷ Do not remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways;
- according to your love remember me, for you, Lord, are good.
- ⁸ Good and upright is the Lord; therefore he instructs sinners in his ways.
- ⁹ He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.

Luke 21:25-36

²⁵ 'There will be signs in the sun, moon and stars. On the earth, nations will be in anguish and perplexity at the roaring and tossing of the sea. ²⁶ People will faint from terror, apprehensive of what is coming on the world, for the heavenly bodies will be shaken. ²⁷ At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. ²⁸ When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.'

²⁹ He told them this parable: 'Look at the fig-tree and all the trees. ³⁰ When they sprout leaves, you can see for yourselves and know that summer is near. ³¹ Even so, when you see these things happening, you know that the kingdom of God is near. ³² 'Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. ³³ Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

³⁴ 'Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap. ³⁵ For it will come on all those who live on the face of the whole earth. ³⁶ Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man.'
