## Readings for today

### Psalm 13

- <sup>1</sup> How long, LORD? Will you forget me for ever?  
How long will you hide your face from me?
- <sup>2</sup> How long must I wrestle with my thoughts  
and day after day have sorrow in my heart?  
How long will my enemy triumph over me?
- <sup>3</sup> Look on me and answer, LORD my God.  
Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death,
- <sup>4</sup> and my enemy will say, 'I have overcome him,'  
and my foes will rejoice when I fall.
- <sup>5</sup> But I trust in your unfailing love;  
my heart rejoices in your salvation.
- <sup>6</sup> I will sing the LORD's praise,  
for he has been good to me.

### Matthew 5: 21-26

- <sup>21</sup> 'You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, "You shall not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment." <sup>22</sup> But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a brother or sister will be subject to judgment. Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, "Raca," is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, "You fool!" will be in danger of the fire of hell.
- <sup>23</sup> 'Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.
- <sup>25</sup> 'Settle matters quickly with your adversary who is taking you to court. Do it while you are still together on the way, or your adversary may hand you over to the judge, and the judge may hand you over to the officer, and you may be thrown into prison. <sup>26</sup> Truly I tell you, you will not get out until you have paid the last penny.

## Suggestions for our Praise and Prayers

**Sun** On this Remembrance Sunday pray that those with memories of any of the wars, but especially the Great War will know the peace of God. Remember, too, all our armed forces in whatever country they are serving and that they may maintain peace in our world.

**Mon** As the Glasgow conference ends, please pray that the resolutions and policies may be converted into practical, effective action with real impact. Pray that attention will continue on these issues, that the drive for change will now be taken up by businesses, local, national and international.
