ANNUAL MEETING SUNDAY 8TH MAY AT THE GUIDE AND SCOUT HQ – please put the date for this important and encouraging meeting in your diary. The meeting will begin at 10.00am and finish with a picnic which should be underway by 12.30pm. The Annual Meeting will replace our usual Sunday services but will include worship and prayer. **PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL (PCC)-** The Annual Meeting will include elections for the PCC. The PCC works with members of the clergy and the churchwardens to ensure the efficient running of the churches. Please consider carefully and prayerfully whether you would like to serve the church in this particular role. Meetings are held approximately every six weeks and we discuss all sorts of interesting and important issues. The PCC plays a vital role in the life of the Church in the Woottons. Nomination forms for membership of the PCC will be available in church shortly, along with forms for the election of sides people and for nominating Churchwardens.

SIDESPEOPLE – the Annual meeting also includes election of Sidespeople. Sidespeople work with the churchwardens and sacristans in preparing the church for worship on Sundays and at other times. They have the very important and enjoyable task of welcoming people to church and making sure that they have everything they need for the service. Please considering offering yourself for this vital role.

SUNDAY SERVICES AND COVID - We request that you wear a face covering/mask when you come to receive communion. You are not obliged to wear them at other times, either when you enter or leave church, or when you take part in all the other parts of the service. However, those who wish to wear face coverings/masks at other times must be encouraged and allowed to do so by all of us in church. At the altar, the priest and assistant will continue to wear face coverings/masks at key points of the preparation and administration of communion. They will use hand sanitiser as has been the practice since the beginning of the pandemic. Wafers and wine (that which will be offered to communicants) will still be kept covered for most of the time, including when the Eucharistic Prayer is said by the priest. Please do not come to church if you do not feel well, or if you are testing positive for COVID. These things are no longer bound by law, they are simply a pastoral request from your James.

JOINT SERVICE TODAY – The Church in the Woottons is a partner Church of the King's Lynn Debt Centre (KLDC) along with King's Lynn Cornerstone Baptist Church, King's Lynn Evangelical Church and King's Centre Church. KLDC works in association with Christians Against Poverty (CAP) to support with individuals and families who are facing serious debt. Since its establishment 5 years ago the Debt Centre has helped 35 households become free of debt. Lives are being transformed through this ministry.
