Toothill Church is part of the West Swindon and Lydiard Tregoze Church Partnership. We
work with members at Westlea School, Holy Trinity Shaw, and St Mary's Lydiard Tregoze. Our members
come from all denominations, or none, but we work closely with and come under the jurisdiction of four
denominations: Anglican, Baptist, United Reformed Church, and Methodist.

Building God's Kingdom in a new context.

There have been some updates around our churches, since the decision at our AGM to work towards dissolving the Partnership. It's time to update you all.

Here we share the statements of intent, made and agreed by the individual Churches, Westlea want to find a new beginning different to the others, and we pray God's blessing on them as they negotiate with others.

HTS - Affirmed a statement that they believe the only way forward is to become solely CofE by governance. While striving to sustain the multi-denominational welcome and ecumenical ethos as much as possible.

St Marys – Affirmed a statement that they believe the only way forward is to become solely CofE by governance. While striving to sustain the multi-denominational welcome and ecumenical ethos as much as possible.

Toothill - We recognise that the Church of England will be the only denomination offering ministerial support for Toothill in the future and that the Partnership will dissolve. Toothill Church will become Church of England by structure and governance. This change will happen over time and is expected to be completed by 2026. In the mean-time we continue to focus on Kingdom values through our culture of welcome, diversity of worship, ministry and outreach. As part of this we welcome and value the ministry of both Rev Mark Tidey and Rev Joseph Riberio, the Circuit and Partnership.

Westlea - Westlea Church will not remain as a single Church. The desire would be to merge with another Church probably outside the current Partnership who shares a desire with Westlea Church in looking to maintain a presence in Westlea. This though will require receiving leadership, attendance and worship leading resource from the merging church, and supporting activities for the community, for example, Litter Picking, Open The Book, Christmas Carols.

Mark and Clive will meet regularly with the Westlea leadership team, to support them as they step into their unknown, and we will keep you up to date.

New beginnings require new ways of working, at present some changes are more urgent than others. We need to move towards new structures and the exec recognises that finances, and safeguarding are the things we need to prioritise. As a consequence, the Children's worker post is on hold,

As suggested by Churches Together in England (CTE) we will be looking to create Charitable Incorporated Organisations (CIOs) for the three churches remaining in the CofE parish. We will need help and expect the Diocese to assist us.

New beginnings bring new opportunities to build God's kingdom, so we hope you will bring your ideas and hopes as well as your questions to our Partnership open meeting on Wed evening, 18th October, 7:30 at Toothill Church. where we can share further with you.
