A Spotlight on: The East Africa Hunger Crisis Right now, one person is likely dying from hunger every 48 seconds in East Africa. The world has missed the chance to avert a massive hunger catastrophe, but there is still hope. It's never too late to save a life. Last week, Save the Children and Oxfam, in collaboration with the the Jameel Observatory for Food Security and Early Action, published a new report 'Dangerous Delays 2: The Cost of Inaction' which highlights the world's repeated failure to act fast to avert preventable hunger crises. This is an important partnership, and very timely given the devastating hunger and nutrition crisis we are seeing right now across the region, which will only get worse with climate change. The Ukraine conflict has also driven already soaring food prices to their highest level ever recorded, making it even harder for millions of families to get enough food.
