name. Amen.



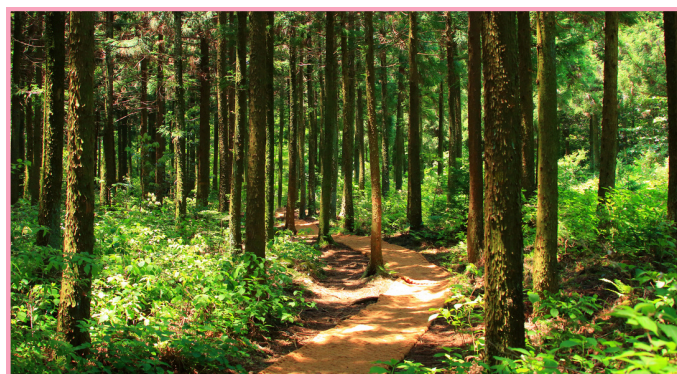
## *Week commencing 13<sup>th</sup> October*

precious name. Amen.



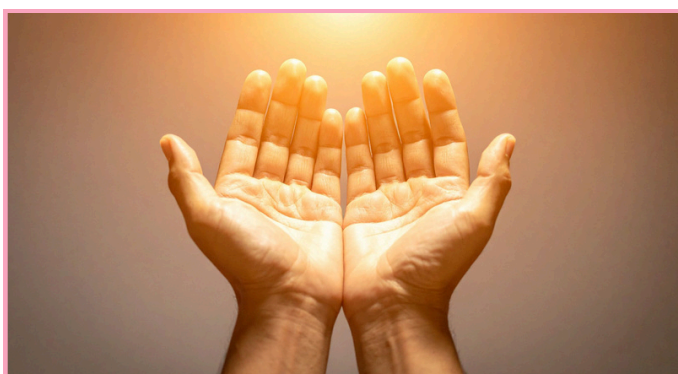
## *Week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> October*
