

REVEREND CHRISTOPHER BAINBRIGG

Reverend Christopher Bainbrigg was born in Westmorland in 1702 and attended Kirkby Stephen School. He went to Cambridge, matriculating in 1724/25. He was made a deacon in 1727 and a priest in 1730; in that year he gained a Bachelor of Law qualification too.

In 1730 he became a curate at Polebrook and in 1735 he became Vicar of Cotterstock and Warmington too. He remained in Cotterstock and Warmington until 1742. It is recorded that in his period of office a Mr Rose was buried in a vault in Cotterstock expeditiously finished that day.
