

## REVEREND DR LLOYD REGINALD CADDICK 1981

Reverend Dr Lloyd Reginald Caddick became the Vicar of Cotterstock in 1981 when it was joined with Oundle and was the Vicar of St Andrew's for four years. When he retired from St Peter's in Oundle in 1996 the parishioners wanted to commission a stone corbel of him to join other corbels on the pillars in the church. Some parishioners were so vehemently opposed to the idea that it was eventually referred to the ecclesiastical court to make a ruling.

In an 87 page judgement Judge Thomas Coningsby, Chancellor of Peterborough Diocese, said there was no aesthetic or legal reason why he should not be represented. Canon Caddick did not object to having a carved image of himself in St Peter's but he was saddened that the idea had caused so much upset.
