



Instructions for Riders and Striders 2021

Thank you for volunteering to Ride and Stride to raise money for Wiltshire's churches. Half of the money you collect goes to your chosen parish and half to the Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust, to enable it to make grants for the upkeep of churches and chapels throughout the county.

This year the Lord Lieutenant of Wiltshire, Mrs. Sarah Troughton, will be launching the event with a 'virtual' start. The video will be posted on Instagram and emailed to all Parish organisers.

We also wish to encourage all Riders and Striders to get involved by posting and sharing photographs of their church visits on Instagram. We hope this will increase both awareness and fundraising.

Organising Your Sponsorship

- Fill in the first section of the Sponsorship Form. (ADD LINK to Heading 4 below)
- Encourage family, friends, church members to sponsor you.
- Ask them, if they are UK tax-payers, to tick the Gift Aid box. In order to be able to claim the 25% tax refund, we need to have their name, initials, house name or number and post code written legibly.
- If you are under 18, please make sure your parent signs the consent box on the form. If under 13, you must be accompanied at all times by a responsible adult.
- You can use JustGiving to widen your appeal for sponsorship. JustGiving is a simple, quick and secure way for people to sponsor you online. The money is paid directly into the Trust's account, with Gift Aid added, thus saving you the bother of having to collect it.
- It is easy to set up your own JustGiving page by using the link on WHCT Rider & Strider Information page or using this link address:

- In the "Story" section of your page, make sure you include the name of your church. You can then contact potential sponsors by email.

Planning Your Route

- You can of course visit churches in other counties.

On the day

- Listen to the weather forecast and dress appropriately. Cyclists are encouraged to wear bright clothes and helmets and to ensure your bike is in good roadworthy condition.
- Be **safety** conscious all the way. Best not to cycle in large groups.
- Observe the Countryside Code.
- Churches may be visited between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.
- At each church get your sponsorship form initialled and/or stamped, with the time of arrival, and sign the register of visitors. If there is no steward there, initial your own form.
- Please take photographs and either post them on our Instagram account (@w-h-c-t) or email them to kcr.rs@btinternet.com. All posted/emailed pictures will be added to the WHCT Instagram account. All pictures will be entered into a competition for the most inspirational picture.
- Enjoy your day!

Prizes

- The event is not a competition, but there are cash prizes for the most churches visited and the most money raised, for cyclists in three age categories (16 and under, over 16, and over 65) and for the most successful walker.
- There are two cups: the Brooke Cup (plus £500) awarded to the best achieving parish, and the Junior Group Cup (plus £100), also generously donated by Lord Brooke of Sutton Mandeville, for the parish with the most successful group of Under-18s.
- The prizes for the photos posted to Instagram and judged by the organisers to be the most inspirational will be: 1st prize £20, 2nd prize £15, 3rd prize £10.

After the event

- Collect money from your sponsors and fill in the amounts on the sponsorship form. If they have ticked the Gift Aid box, please ensure that their name, initials, home address and post code are clearly legible.
- Cheques should be made payable to **Wiltshire Historic Churches Trust**.
- Pass your form and sponsorship money to your Parish Organiser **by Sunday 10th October**.
- Your parish's half share of the money raised will be sent to your Parish Organiser in November. If you wish to divide the money between different churches, please make this clear on your sponsorship form.
