Ps.94,9: *“Does he who fashioned the ear not hear? Does he who formed the eye not see?”*

Mt.6,8: *“You Father knows what you need before you ask him.”*

Going and acting on false assumptions takes one on collision course with reality (94,8). Guarding against it would seem a basic requirement of wisdom and any justification of knowledge (94,8).
Therefore:

Guard against the assumption that God does not see nor that there is anything anywhere at any time that God does not see (94,9);

Guard against the assumption that God does not hear, indeed that anything is said that God does not know even before it is said (94,9);

Guard against the assumption that God does not see and weigh what the nations are doing and that he does not punish them (94,10);

Guard against the assumption that what God has revealed is not (necessarily) for knowing and that all things are not what God knows them to be (94,10);

Guard against the assumption that leaving God out consigns human plans to anything but futility (94,11).

But God sees all and hears all and knows all. And though He is Judge, He is also, in Christ Jesus, the Redeemer.
