Services designated '**Book ahead**' require you to do so by contacting the Rector up to 2 weeks in advance, so that he can ensure that 'safe numbers' are maintained in our two churches.

**Do not attend without booking**, but please give notice if you have need to cancel your booking so places can be made available to others.

Booking for services at *Woodmancote* on 6 & 25 December may allow priority for residents of that community or regular worshippers at Woodmancote ahead of others. You may initially be able to book for one (but **not both**) of the *Christmas Carol Services in the Parish Church*, in the likely situation that there is insufficient room for everyone who wishes to attend.
