## A Letter from our Superintendent Rev. Nick Thompson

Dear Friends,

Welcome to another Circuit Plan for these next three months. We do not know what these months will bring in terms of the development of the coronavirus pandemic but it may well be that we can begin to gather again in our churches over this time and to worship God in a physical way as well as online. Conversations are ongoing in our Churches as we hold this time in prayer and seek to discern what it is that God wants for us and the communities which we serve in his name.

Government guidance says that we can begin to worship in our buildings again from now but with inevitable restrictions on numbers. We long to be together in fellowship but we cannot do so fully as rightly we observe social distancing. We cannot sing as we love to do so in services. It may be that some of our churches will decide not to reopen just yet and for many of us online worship has brought a new found creativity to come before God in new ways. Certainly, our online services continue to attract new people to worship – some of whom would not want to come into a physical building – and we will keep these services alongside our other worship. We have the challenge to grow through both as we become what some call a new Hybrid Church.

As some of us may return into our Churches we know that we cannot just go back to the way things were before these times. We have learnt new things and had time to reflect on what God is calling us to leave behind too.

Life moves on at pace. It has been a time of sudden changes. The weather has been extreme at times with blazing sunshine and heavy showers. Overseas travel opened up and then shut down again especially for those wanting to travel to Spain. Face coverings are now obligatory in shops and from this Sunday in places of worship too. These

## Services In This Quarter in Church Or Not?

Dear Friends

Please note that we have made this Plan in the midst of the ever-changing situation of the Coronavirus pandemic. Our churches are considering when or whether to reopen their buildings during this next quarter and taking on board all the restrictions that are imposed on public worship at the time. The Managing Trustees of each Church will decide in each case what is right for their Society and keep all things under review.

So, this Plan provides a basis for us to go forward but still leaves the flexibility of each Church to decide when or whether it should reopen.

Similarly, Preachers have given their dates to us in the usual way but each Preacher has the right not to take a particular service depending on their own concerns for safety or that of their household at any point on the Plan. Or they may offer to help a local congregation to prepare a service without actually being present themselves. Conversations about this are beginning already.

It may well be that Government guidance changes radically at a particular point and we will have to take this on board then.

We are committed to providing online worship through this time from Marlow and Wesley also and I will establish with the Staff and the CLT how best to resource this. We will however doubtless make good use of preachers who are not able to lead services in Church buildings or whose originally planned services are not in fact happening! Some Churches may choose to gather and watch one of the online services and so worship in this way as Cryers Hill have begun to do.

We will have a clearer idea by Circuit Meeting on 17th September as to the overall situation. Please do bear with us through these really unusual times and let's trust in God to lead us in the right ways through these months.

It may be really tough to begin worshipping together again and yet face so many restrictions. However, we need to continue to look ahead. Our longing for some of us to get back to normal is a natural one, but we have a long road ahead of us and none of us knows what normal may look like in 6 months or 6 years time.

As we travel faithfully and hopefully as a Circuit, we will be picking up the “God For All” initiative which was passed at Conference this summer. This says that the Methodist Church in Britain is called to be a growing, evangelistic, inclusive Church of Gospel people who speak of, listen for and live out the goodness of a God for all people.

Like a tree planted by the water (Psalm 1:3, Jeremiah 17:8) the Church rooted in God will grow naturally in courage, life and beauty.

There are eight commitments which we are encouraged to explore over the next 5 years with a focus in the next year on just one or two. The first commitment is to be Centred in God which may sound really obvious but which gives us the opportunity to be renewed in his love and grace as we begin the next chapter of our lives together.

I am praying for us all and all our churches in their rich diversity. Richard Goldstraw reminded us at Circuit Leadership Team that he sees different signs of God’s Spirit at work in each of our Churches and this is an encouragement to us all!

May we trust in God through these months and allow him to lead and guide us in all things as we worship, serve and reach out to others and tell our stories of faith and wonder in our uncertain world.
