A Letter from our Superintendent Rev. Nick Thompson

Dear Friends

As we begin another quarter of services across our Churches we do so with much uncertainty once again as to what our worship will look like across Advent, Christmas and beyond.

As I write we are just beginning another period of national lockdown which is due to end on December 2nd but in the grip of a rising second wave of the Coronavirus we don't know that for sure.

This lockdown of course is rather different to the first one as for some life does not feel so very different. Unlike in the Spring, schools, colleges and universities are still open. There is no restriction on the number of times each day that we can leave our houses - assuming we are able to and wish to do so within the guidelines. Our churches must be closed for public worship but we may open them for private prayer and three of our Churches are looking to do so.

Our online services have continued through the more relaxed summer months even as many of our churches have reopened and these continue through lockdown of course. They continue to be valued by many in the Circuit and far beyond and I am sure we will carry on with this new found ministry long into the future as other Circuits and Churches are planning to do.

Overall our liberty has been restricted for the sake of others and rightly so. We are ever mindful of the care we exercise to our neighbours and we seek to protect them as we care for ourselves too.

We recognise however that lockdown in November is not easy. Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote to his parents in November 1943 from prison saying, "Now the dismal autumn days have begun and one has to try to get light from within." We remember more than ever this year that it is when the darkness is deepest that the light of Christ shines most brightly.

Whether we are worshipping in churches through this Plan or online we will be together in seeking the Light of Christ shining in the darkness and remembering the Hope which this brings.
