Welcome to our Father's Day Service. Father's Day gives us the opportunity to show our appreciation for our fathers and for all men who have cared for us, and to thank God for them. We can also remember that Jesus himself grew up in a normal family and so understands both the joys and the stresses of living with other people. We are the family of God and we thank Him for the amazing love he has for us, his family, and remember that God wants us to love one another.

Father's Day was founded in Spokane Washington at the YMCA in 1910 by Sonora Smart Dodd, who was born in Arkansas. Its first celebration was in the Spokane YMCA on June 19th, 1910. Her father, the Civil War veteran William Jackson Smart, was a single parent who raised his six children there.

The tradition of celebrating Father's Day gradually spread to other countries, including the United Kingdom. However, the holiday did not become an official holiday in the UK until much later. In fact, it wasn't until 1972 that Father's Day was officially recognised in the UK.

These days it is a day for showing our appreciation to dads, through the giving of cards and presents. Today we want to show our appreciation to all men and to celebrate the goodness and love shown to us by all men who care for us or who are part of our lives. We also want to remember that this goodness comes from God.

Kings Club - What Jairus' Daughter saw in her father

Mark Ch.5 21-24, 35-43

Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea. 22 And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet 23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, "My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live." 24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him

35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue's house who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?" 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not be afraid; only believe." 37 And He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James, and John the brother of James.

Grace

38 Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and saw a tumult and those who wept and wailed loudly. 39 When He came in, He said to them, "Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping." 40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying.

41 Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, "Talitha, cumi," which is translated, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." 42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement. 43 But He commanded them strictly that no one should know it, and said that something should be given her to eat.

Jairus's daughter saw that her father was not ashamed to seek Jesus. He did not send his wife. He did not send a servant. He did not send someone else. He sought out Jesus himself.

Maya

Jairus's daughter saw that her father was not ashamed to bring Christ into His home. The Jewish leaders in various places had some very negative things to say about Jesus. Jairus would not allow his family to be denied the benefit of Jesus just because of what others said. Jairus would not be influenced by the bias of others. He was willing to do what He knew to be right. He invited the King of Glory into His house.

Jaymisha

Jairus's daughter saw that her father was not afraid to express his love toward her. Love compelled Jairus to leave the side of his sick daughter in search of the One who could heal her. Leaving her in her crucial hour of sickness had to be a tough decision. Fathers have to decide to do what is right for their family. Jairus sought out Jesus because he loved his daughter and wanted her to live and be restored to physical health.


