

## RUISHTON CEMETERY DIRECTORY MAY 2017

This cemetery was designed with eight rows each with space for about 34 plots giving approximately 270 burials. This is too large to lend itself to single convenient presentation.

For simplicity on A4 paper there are two sections, South and North. Each section has eight rows with up to 18 graves in each row.

Not all graves are able to be identified, the gaps do not mean that the plot is empty it is just the details are unknown, several with a flower vase only.

Plot numbering is from South to North in each section. The first row starts at the South gate and follows the East boundary fence heading North. South row numbers start at the South boundary wall.

Some graves may be unmarked, without memorial details, or have been completely overgrown. This record largely follows the numbering on a chart held by the church dated 1995.

The author is grateful for details from an earlier survey by Sir Melvyn Medlycott (2004) has been used to fill in some information which has now been obscured by vegetation or weathering.
